June 8, 2022 - Wednesday

Vatican Museums & St. Peter's Basilica

After a delicious breakfast, we are off to another country! Ten minutes drive from our hotel and we are in the Vatican City! We will tour the Vatican museums, a treasure trove of ancient Greek sculptures, medieval tapestries, and Renaissance paintings. Our visit culminates at the Sistine Chapel, the room where the Pope is elected. Next, we visit St. Peter's Basilica, by far the largest church in Christendom.

We will see Michelangelo's Pieta, sculpted when he was just 24, as well as Bernini's seven-story bronze canopy located above the main altar. The afternoon is at leisure - time for shopping, Ladies! B

June 9, 2022 - Thursday

Ancient Rome

After a hearty breakfast, we are ready to step back in time and visit "Ancient Rome", including the Roman Forum and the Colosseum. Its real name was the Flavian Amphitheatre after the emperors who built it in the first century AD. Colosseum refers to the "colossal" statue of Nero that at one time stood at the entrance. A relaxing afternoon awaits. Find your own favorite Piazza (little square), people-watch, or continue exploring the picturesque and narrow streets just around our hotel. B

June 10, 2022 - Friday

Rome - Gaeta

First we will enjoy breakfast, and then will discover the Ulysses Riviera as we follow a special itinerary named after the legendary journey and adventures of Ulysses, who with his companions landed in Gaeta, and was placed under the magical spell of the sorceress Circe. Visiting Gaeta is like stepping back in time. It has been home to artists and writers of the 20th century and continues to have an air of the 1930s about it. You will discover a piece of authentic Italy through good food, natural beaches, preserved historical and religious sites, and the views ... they will simply take your breath away. We will visit the baroque church of Santissima Annunziata dating back to the 1320s and listen to its unique story. We will enjoy an afternoon strolling through the picturesque "Via Indipendenza"

- pedestrian street and walk the colorful alleys with small houses in pastel tones, flowery windows, cast-iron balconies, and hanging laundry. You will enjoy the many artisan shops and we will make a stop at the ancient bakery where Mr. Enrico will greet us and serve the local Tiella - it doesn't get any better than this! Dinner is served and the evening is yours to relax. B | S | D

June 11, 2022 - Saturday

Gaeta

After a quiet breakfast, we take off to enjoy a walking tour of Sperlonga, another small seaside village characterized by white houses, placed on a peninsula and rightly awarded as one of the most beautiful towns in Italy. This ancient and magnificent old town with its narrow and terraced streets was originally a fortress protecting the local population against invaders from abroad. About one mile from the town, close to the beach and on a very charming route, we find the National Archaeological Museum that shows the "Marble Odyssey" and archaeological area of the residence of the Emperor Tiberius, characterized by a grotto where marble sculptures were placed during the Roman Age. This afternoon we will stop in close-by Itri, noted for the cultivation of olives and the production of excellent olive oil. For centuries, the Itrana olives have been marketed using the name of Olive di Gaeta as they were exported by ship from the nearby port of Gaeta. We will make a stop for olive oil tasting. Return to our hotel in the afternoon for an evening at leisure. B | T



June 12, 2022 - Sunday

Gaeta - Sorrento

After a delicious breakfast, we will take a beautiful southern-bound drive to Sorrento. On the way, we will stop at a nationally recognized non-profit orphanage that works directly with thousands of homeless youth across Italy. The organization was founded by a group of volunteers, and every day they assist a group of 50 children. We will learn about the organization and the daily routine and challenges.

We proceed to Sorrento, a small resort-town overlooking the Bay of Naples and the beautiful Mediterranean Sea. For over 2,000 years, visitors from across the globe have been attracted to Sorrento by its breathtaking sunsets and fragrances of the famous lemon trees. We unpack our bags and will enjoy two nights in this beautiful place. Dinner is served at a local restaurant tonight. B | D

June 13, 2022 - Monday

Positano - Amalfi ...by private boat!

After a relaxing breakfast, we are off to explore the beauty of the Amalfi Coast by our own private boat! Today's excursion is the most peaceful way to experience this unique coastline. Departing from Sorrento, we will cruise along the beautiful beaches and you will have the opportunity to swim in the crystal-clear and blue Mediterranean sea. We will enjoy a light snack on board, while heading towards Positano. Here we will have time at leisure (approximately 2 hours) to visit the city, walk the "peculiar" street, and enjoy the local shops. Back on board, we will cruise to Amalfi where we will stop to visit the village (approximately 2 hours) before returning to Sorrento. B | S

June 14, 2022 - Tuesday

Capri

After a filling breakfast, we transfer to the Sorrento pier* to catch the hydrofoil that whisks us to the Isle of Capri, the magical and colorful island that has been a favorite resort destination since the time of the Roman Republic. With Amalfi at our stern, Capri at our bow, we will sail to one of the world's most enchanting islands! We will enjoy a full-day guided excursion to the Isle of Capri, visit the lovely Anacapri, and explore the charming shops and chic boutiques as we stroll the island's narrow streets. We continue to "La Piazzetta," the social heart of the island (and home to international jet-setters), on our way to the open-air Gardens of Augustus, from where we will take in the breathtaking views of the famous Faraglioni Rocks. An optional tour (weather permitting) is offered to the Grotta Azzurra (the Blue Grotto). World-famous for its translucent aqua-blue light filtering through the water by way of an opening below sea level, this is definitely a unique experience. With the exodus of the day-trippers, the island turns into the most delightful and tranquil place for us to enjoy, before calling it a day. B

*Our luggage will be safely stored away and meet us again at our arrival to Naples tomorrow. Pack a small bag for your Capri overnight.

June 15, 2022 - Wednesday

Pompeii - Naples

An early breakfast is served and we head to the harbor for a short one-hour ferry crossing to Naples. We meet our motor coach and driver, and in the shadow of Mt. Vesuvius, we stop to recall a moment

in history at Pompeii; an ancient community buried in volcanic ash and mud. Brought to an abrupt halt 2,200 years ago, when the volcano erupted, daily life just stopped in the middle of everyday activities. Following the ancient roads of the city, we will explore the well-preserved ruins of homes, stores, temples, and public spaces visually narrating what Roman life was like in this 1st-century city. We return to Naples for our last evening. From romantic couples on Vespas to wet laundry hanging over the streets ...from more heated words and smiles than anywhere else in the country to 2,000 years of ancient history ...Naples is a city that will show you all that life in Italy represents, complete with a captivating Italian accent! Naples is said to be the superlative of everything that is truly Italian: from the best to the tempestuous, but for us, it's the birthplace of pizza and Sophia Loren ...now what could be better? They say the best pizza in Italy is served in Naples and our farewell dinner is no exception as we sit down to taste the real thing! B | D
