August 13, 2025 - Wednesday Copenhagen - Oslo

This morning, we will take a short one-hour flight to Oslo, Norway. Oslo is the capital of Norway, the "Viking Capital," founded in 1040. With a location by the Oslo Fjord, it is home to many fascinating museums and beautiful green parks full of sculptures. In the city center, you will find the majestic Karl Johan pedestrian street and the impressive opera house. Upon arrival at Oslo airport, we will meet our local tour director and driver. drive to visit Hadeland Glassverk, the oldest glasswork company in Norway, founded in 1762 and still in operation. We will tour the Glassverk, and lunch will be served at its cozy restaurant. We will arrive in the center of Oslo to check into our hotel and enjoy an evening to relax and unwind. B | L

August 14, 2025 - Thursday Oslo

Breakfast is enjoyed before we head out to learn more about Oslo. We are off for an orientation tour where you get to admire the Royal Palace, the National Theater, the Parliament, the Opera House by the waterfront, and the medieval Akershus Fortress. Lunch is served at a local cafe before visiting the Kon Tiki Museum, where we will experience Thor Heyerdahl's world-famous expeditions across the Pacific Ocean on the balsawood raft in 1947. Up next is the open-air Norwegian Folk Museum, which showcases life in Norway from 1500 to the present. Among the 160 buildings, the Gol Stave Church, dating from 1200, is one of the five medieval gems at the museum. We return to our hotel in the late afternoon to enjoy an evening at leisure. B | L

August 15, 2025 - Friday Bergen by Train

Breakfast is served, and our bags are packed*. Today, we will take a scenic train journey from Oslo to Bergen (approx. seven hours). Cameras out; the landscapes and sceneries are stunning! We arrive in "The Capital of the Fjords" in the afternoon in time to take a walk around the center and harbor. Dinner at our hotel. *Our bags are transferred separately; you will only carry a light handbag. B | D



August 16, 2025 - Saturday Bergen

After a hearty breakfast, we will take a morning tour of Bergen and experience Bryggen, the historic harbor district and one of North Europe's oldest port cities on the west coast of Norway. It was established as a center for trade by the 12th century. In 1350, the Hanseatic League established a "Hanseatic Office" in Bergen. They gradually acquired ownership of Bryggen and controlled the trade in stockfish from Northern Norway through privileges granted by the Crown. Bryggen has been on the UNESCO list of World Cultural Heritage sites since 1979. A concert is enjoyed at Troldhaugen, at the Edvard Grieg Museum. Edvard Grieg is widely considered one of the leading Romantic era composers, and his music is part of the standard classical repertoire worldwide. A delicious salmon lunch is served before we take the funicular to the top of Mount Fløyen (1,000 ft. above sea level) for a stunning view of the city and the surrounding fjords. Have fun in Bergen by night! B | L

August 17, 2025 - Sunday

Myrdal, Flåm, Sognefjord Cruise Ahead await two of the most famous adventures in Norway: Flåm Railway and a Sognefjord cruise. We board one of the most exceptional railroads in the world from Bergen to Flåm via Myrdal, with breathtaking views at every curve. With rivers cutting through deep ravines, waterfalls tumbling down precipitous mountainsides, and white peaks with small farms clinging to steep slopes. A journey on the Flåm Railway is a trip through Norwegian nature ...oh, what a joy! In



Flåm, we embark on a two-hour mini-cruise of the Nærøy and Auerland Fjords - both branches of the Sognefjord, the longest and deepest fjord in the world. Our motorcoach will meet us in Gudvangen and transfer us back to Bergen for the night. B | L
