Arrive in San Jose

Let the adventure begin as we arrive in San Jose and meet our Professional Naturalist Tour Director and transfer to your hotel. San José, the bustling capital of Costa Rica, serves as the vibrant heart of the country, where a blend of rich cultural heritage, dynamic arts, and modern amenities come together amid the scenic backdrop of the Central Valley. On the 4th voyage of Christopher Columbus in 1502, the explorer

and his crew discovered the Caribbean side of a beautiful territory he called, "Costa Rica" or "Rich Coast" where we will venture tomorrow. Costa Rica is Central America's greatest hidden gem, a haven for eco-tourism featuring lush forests, magnificent waterfalls, rumbling volcanoes and diverse ecosystems. We will transfer to our hotel for an overnight stay in lovely San Jose.

October 30, 2025 - Thursday

Tour our way to Tortuguero

After breakfast, journey east to the Caribbeanshore and Tortuguero National Park. On the way, stop and enjoy a coffee plantation for a visit and tour. Next, pass by several banana plantations and see one of Costa Rica's main exports being harvested. Later, board a motor launch for your cruise along the Tortuguero Canals, waterways crisscrossing a national park dedicated to the protection of endangered turtles. The trained eyes of your guide and boatman help you spot freshwater turtles, caimans, herons, toucans, egrets, and monkeys. An afternoon at leisure lets you explore your jungle lodge until you meet for an informative slideshow presentation on the area. At your lodge, enjoy an included lunch and check-in for a two night stay.

Happy Halloween!

This morning enjoy a guided walking tour through the local trails with some free time before lunch. In the afternoon, visit Tortuguero National Park and experience the "Amazon of Costa Rica" aboard small open boats with an opportunity to see macaws, sloths, monkeys and other native species. While on this spectacular boat cruise through the various canals be sure to keep an eye out for wildlife including howler monkeys, sloths, toucans, aquatic birds, crocodiles, caimans and exotic flora. November 1, 2025 - Saturday

Sarapiqui & Pineapple Farm Tour

A morning boat transfer begins your journey to the Sarapiqui area which is known for ornamental plants, banana, and pineapple plantations. Tour a pineapple farm owned by a local family, and learn about the history, cultivation, and industry of pineapples and other indigenous crops. Continue to your hotel in the lush town of Arenal, located in the shadow of Arenal Volcano. After settling in, enjoy some free time before dinner.

Feliz Dia de los Muertos! (or Happy Day of the Dead!)

Each year in Costa Rica on November 2nd is a time to remember and celebrate deceased loved ones. Although more exuberantly celebrated in Mexico, Costa Ricans take this opportunity to celebrate their dearly departed by visiting cemeteries and grave sites, laying flowers and candles, and holding Catholic masses.

November 2, 2025 - Sunday

Today, explore a family-owned farm, getting a peek into the daily lives of the locals. During a tour of the gardens, learn how the plants are organically grown through the concept of sustainability. The farm considers itself a "classroom without borders." Taste the exotic fruit harvest and experience the traditional way to process sugar cane before engaging in a culinary demonstration and a farm-to-table. B | L

November 3, 2025 - Monday

Lake Arenal & Monteverde Cloud Forest Enjoy a delightful cruise on Lake Arenal, Costa Rica's largest and most important lake. Then, it's off to the secluded Monteverde Cloud Forest, a place you have to see to believe, where trees grow to heights of 100 feet. Set off on a nature walk through this



spectacular ecosystem, where you're sure to encounter many incredible species of flora and fauna. B \mid D

November 4, 2025 - Tuesday

Santa Elena Cloud Forest & Ecological Sanctuary

This morning, visit Santa Elena Cloud Forest for a leisurely paced "Hanging Bridges" walking tour. Over 600 species of butterflies and 400 species of birds have been recorded inside this private reserve, along with 100 reptile and 120 mammal species that hide within the dense vegetation.

Later, visit the family-owned Ecological Sanctuary, where you will explore the trails through coffee and banana plantations filled with endemic wildlife and beautiful scenery. Have your camera ready at every turn! B | D

November 5, 2025 - Wednesday

Sarchi Village & Grecia Village

Following breakfast this morning, travel to visit Sarchi Village, known as the center of Costa Rican handcrafts where you will see the artists in their workshops making the famous oxcarts. Next stop is Grecia Village to see the metal church that was imported from Belgium to Puerto Limon in 1897. The church was transported by oxcarts to



its present-day location but sat in the plaza for 10 years before being reconstructed. This evening toast to the pura Vida of Costa Rica over a farewell dinner. B | D

- Group airfare comes with **seat assignments 30 days prior to departure.** We cannot confirm precise seat numbers earlier than 30 days prior to your departure and therefore cannot guarantee the availability of specific seating on the aircraft. We do our best to honor your preferences (window, aisle seat).
- Premium seating upgrades depending on availabilities:

Main Cabin Extra can be purchased and confirmed **once the tickets are issued** = 30 days prior to departure. Estimate a supplement of \$400-\$800.

Premium Economy can be reserved **at the time of booking** your trip with us. Estimate a supplement of \$2,500-\$4,000.

Business Class can be reserved **at the time of booking** your trip with us. Estimate a supplement of \$7,000-\$10,000.
