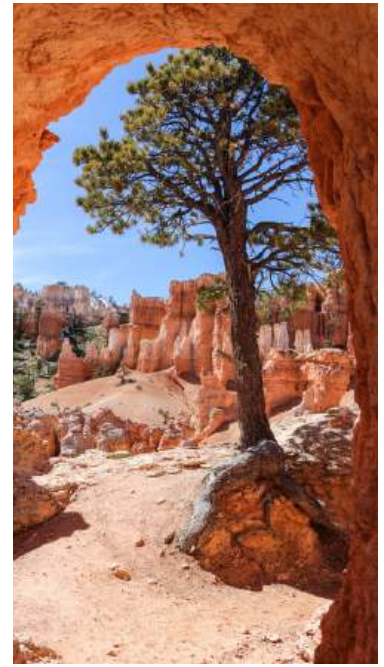

September 17, 2026 - Thursday
Welcome to Arizona (Scottsdale)

September 18, 2026 - Friday
Sedona's Red Rocks & the Grand Canyon

This morning, climb aboard your motorcoach and set out through a landscape painted in desert hues—rust, sage, and gold. The drive to Sedona is breathtaking, and as the red rock formations rise dramatically around you, you'll understand why

so many artists, writers, and dreamers have found inspiration here. Enjoy a guided Sedona Trolley Tour that takes you to the Chapel of the Holy Cross—an architectural wonder built into the crimson cliffs—and to Airport Mesa, where sweeping vistas seem to stretch forever. Your guide will share local stories and legends that bring this region to life. Spend a leisurely afternoon in Uptown Sedona browsing its charming galleries, artisan boutiques, and cafes before continuing through the winding beauty of Oak Creek Canyon and the cool pines of Kaibab National Forest. As the day fades, arrive at the Grand Canyon and settle in for two nights near one of the world's greatest natural wonders. B | D

September 19, 2026 - Saturday
A Day at the Grand Canyon

Few experiences can prepare you for your first full glimpse of the Grand Canyon. This morning, watch as the sunrise paints the cliffs in shades of rose, amber, and violet—an ever-changing canvas millions of years in the making. Spend the day exploring at your own pace. Walk the South Rim Trail for breathtaking views, visit the historic El Tovar Hotel for a bit of nostalgia and perhaps an ice cream from its famous parlor, or browse the park's gift shops for handcrafted souvenirs. The canyon invites quiet reflection; it's a place to breathe deeply, to feel small in the best possible way, and to marvel at nature's artistry. B

September 20, 2026 - Sunday
Grand Canyon to Lake Powell

After breakfast, follow the canyon's eastern rim, stopping at scenic overlooks that reveal new angles of its grandeur. Pause at Desert View Tower, where a historic stone watchtower offers panoramic vistas and photo opportunities. From there, continue to Cameron Trading Post, a beloved stop along the Little Colorado River where travelers have gathered since 1916. Browse the shelves for authentic Native American jewelry, pottery, and weavings before heading north toward Lake Powell. The transition from red cliffs to sparkling blue water is nothing short of magical. This afternoon, enjoy a relaxing cruise on Lake Powell, gliding past sandstone cliffs

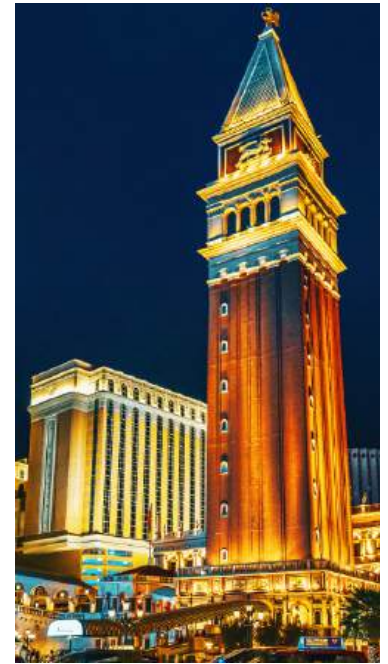

that twist and turn into the narrow walls of Antelope Canyon. The golden light and reflections on the water create a scene of pure serenity. Tonight, share dinner with your companions and watch the desert stars emerge over this tranquil oasis. B | D

September 21, 2026 - Monday Monument Valley Magic

Today, awaken to a sense of wonder as you travel into the Navajo Nation and the iconic beauty of Monument Valley. Known for its soaring red monoliths and vast desert panoramas, this is sacred land—both cinematic and deeply spiritual. Stop for a traditional lunch before joining your Navajo guide for an off-road tour through the valley aboard a four-wheel vehicle. Your guide will share stories passed down through generations, explaining the legends behind formations like “The Mittens” and “John Ford Point.” You’ll feel transported to another time as the wind whispers across the mesas and the colors shift with the sun. Return to Lake Powell this evening for a peaceful night, perhaps sipping tea on the terrace as you replay the day’s images in your mind. B | L

September 22, 2026 - Tuesday Bryce Canyon to Zion

This morning, journey north toward Bryce Canyon National Park—a place so unique it feels otherworldly. Here, thousands of delicately carved spires known as hoodoos rise in shades of red, coral, pink, and cream. The park’s natural amphitheaters glow in the sunlight, creating endless photo opportunities. Stroll along the rim trail, listen to the quiet breeze, and let the moment sink in. Later, travel through southern Utah’s scenic backcountry to the lush valleys of Zion National Park. Towering cliffs in tones of gold and crimson frame your arrival, and the fresh mountain air is a refreshing contrast to the desert landscapes you’ve left behind. Settle into your welcoming hotel near the park and enjoy a restful evening surrounded by nature’s grandeur. B

September 23, 2026 - Wednesday Zion’s Splendor & Las Vegas Lights

Today, explore the heart of Zion National Park on a leisurely tram tour. The towering sandstone walls, cascading waterfalls, and peaceful rivers create a sense of calm and connection that’s

hard to put into words. Take time to savor the moment—perhaps a short walk, a quiet gaze up the canyon walls, or simply sitting still, surrounded by the song of birds and the rustle of leaves. By afternoon, your journey shifts from nature’s sanctuary to the sparkling energy of Las Vegas. Check into your comfortable hotel and enjoy a panoramic tour of the city’s famous Strip and historic downtown. - Group airfare comes with **seat assignments 30 days prior to departure**. We do our best to honor your preferences (window, aisle seat).
- **Premium seating upgrades - depending on availabilities:**
Economy Plus (main cabin, closer to the front of the aircraft, extra leg space) can be purchased and confirmed once the tickets are issued = 30 days prior to departure.
