September 9, 2027 - Thursday

Traveling to Athens, Greece

Your inspiring journey begins as we board our overnight flight to Athens. Settle in, enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service, and let the excitement build as you embark on your dream odyssey.

September 10, 2027 - Friday

Athens

Welcome to Athens! Upon arrival, we'll meet our private tour guide, who will accompany us throughout the journey. Before reaching the city, we stop at Cape Sounion, where the majestic Temple of Poseidon rises dramatically above the Aegean. A delightful seaside lunch follows before we continue to our hotel. Athens—one of the world's oldest cities—is rich with myths, mysteries, and enduring legends. Its sacred ancient sites, vibrant neighborhoods, and cosmopolitan energy create a captivating blend of old and new. The city flourished in the fifth century BC, when Athenian democracy shaped daily life in the Bouleterion and open discussion thrived in the Agora. Check into our hotel for an evening at leisure to relax and unwind. If you're still awake, take a moonlit stroll by the Acropolis—it's right next door.

September 11, 2027 - Saturday

Athens

After a delightful breakfast, we will head out to discover Athens. A short distance by foot takes us to the Acropolis, dominated by the Parthenon and built as a temple to honor goddess Athena in the 5th century BC. From the top of the hill, you will see the Agora, where Socrates, Plato, and Aristotle strolled. Next, we will visit the stunning Acropolis Museum, where lunch is served. We will continue by motorcoach through

the city to see the House of Parliament at Syntagma Square, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Public Library, the University, and the Panathenaic Stadium, where the first Olympics of the modern era were held. The late afternoon and evening are yours to enjoy the city. Don't miss old town Plaka with its numerous shops (open until late!), enjoy people-watching and a local "meze" (plate with small bites) - the best way to taste the local delicacies. B | L

September 12, 2027 - Sunday

Santorini

Today, we will embark on a six-hour ferry ride to Santorini, a truly magical island, a sparkling jewel in the Aegean Sea, famous for its whitewashed houses set against the backdrop of the cobalt blue sea and its black sand beaches. Molded by fire and sea, its majestic cliffs are said to guard the secrets of Atlantis. Upon arrival, we will explore the wines and delicacies of Santorini. We stroll through the ancient vineyards and discover the famous "kouloura," an ancient Phoenician technique for growing grapes in baskets. Check into our hotel for an evening at leisure. Bask in the golden sunset, relax, and unwind in one of the most beautiful places in the world. B | T | L

September 13, 2027 - Monday

Santorini

Today, we will visit the Archaeological Museum in Fira (Thira). Then, time on your own to explore more of Santorini. In the late afternoon, we have arranged a tour of Oia to take in the spectacular sunset and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant! B | D

September 14, 2027 - Tuesday

Naxos

In the morning, we will board our ferry to Naxos (a short ferry crossing of 90

minutes). Hora (the Capital) is a port town filled with whitewashed, cube-shaped houses and medieval Venetian mansions. The island offers everything from delicious food and local liquors to beautiful white marble, incredible Cycladic scenery, local crafts, and some of the best beaches in Greece. We will experience it all! Our five-night stay in Naxos will be something you will never forget, and the island is the perfect base for visits to the surrounding islands. In the afternoon, we will take a walking tour of Naxos Town with tastings of local delicacies: cheeses, citrus liqueurs (kitron), and sweet pastries. Enjoy a night at leisure. B | T/L

September 15, 2027 - Wednesday

Naxos

Enjoy breakfast at our own pace before boarding our motorcoach for an island tour. Experience local villages and stunning scenery. We will learn about daily life, and be introduced to the history of local art. We will savor lunch at our tour guide's favorite tavern. It doesn't get much better than this. The late afternoon and evening are yours to relax and enjoy swimming in the crystal-clear waters. B | L

September 16, 2027 - Thursday

Mykonos & Delos

In the light of the early morning we make our way to take a short ferry ride to Mykonos (45 minutes). From there, we will embark on our "caiques" for the sacred cradle of the Greek gods and goddesses - Delos. Greek mythology tells the legend of how the island of Delos appeared suddenly amidst the waves of the sea when Leto was looking for a safe place to give birth to her twins Apollo and Artemis. The birthplace of the deities was considered so sacred, in fact, that the island was declared off-limits for births and deaths of mortals. Return

to Mykonos in time for a leisurely lunch and time to stroll and explore before we return to Naxos. B

September 17, 2027 - Friday

Paros & Antiparos

Today, we will cross over to Paros (a 30-minute ferry ride) to discover the gentle charm of this captivating island. Paros beautifully blends elegance, history, and effortless relaxation. Wander through Naoussa, a graceful fishing village where whitewashed lanes meet a sparkling harbor filled with boutique cafés and inviting seaside views. Continue to Lefkes, a serene mountain village offering cool breezes, traditional stone paths, and a peaceful glimpse into authentic island life—perfect for unhurried moments of appreciation. In Parikia, we will admire the magnificent Church of Panagia Ekatonpiliani (the Church of the Hundred Gates), one of Greece's oldest and most beautiful churches—an inspiring place of quiet reflection and timeless spiritual grace. Just a 10-minute ferry ride away lies Antiparos, another relaxed little gem with golden beaches, chic cafés, and a warm, friendly village atmosphere. It's no wonder Tom Hanks likes to hang out here—the island offers the perfect blend of simplicity and charm (keep your sunglasses ready... you never know whom you might spot!). Our visit includes a delightful island tour and a trip to the famous Antiparos Cave, where impressive stalactites and centuries-old inscriptions create a true sense of wonder and gentle adventure. After a lovely day, we will return to Naxos in the late afternoon for a laid-back, easygoing evening. B

Crete - Heraklion

After breakfast, we'll take the ferry (3 hours 30 minutes) to Heraklion, Crete, where a relaxing change of pace awaits. After checking into our comfortable hotel, the afternoon is yours to unwind, refresh, or simply enjoy the gentle rhythm of the city. In the evening, we'll take a pleasant stroll through Heraklion's lively streets, soaking in its history and welcoming atmosphere, before ending the day with dinner at a delightful local restaurant, celebrating Cretan flavors and warm island hospitality. Today invites us to step deeply into the ancient world. From there, we travel to legendary Knossos, the palace of King Minos, where myth and history intertwine. As you wander through its restored halls and sunlit courtyards, it's easy to imagine the grandeur of a culture that shaped the ancient Aegean. In the afternoon, we head to Arolithos, a traditional Cretan village nestled in the hills. Here, we'll enjoy a hands-on cooking experience, learning authentic recipes passed down through generations and savoring the delicious dishes we prepare together. (Fun note: Crete is widely recognized as one of the birthplaces of the Mediterranean Diet—a way of eating celebrated for its freshness, balance, and vitality. Early research revealed that
